

# Coldharbour Mill Volunteer Role Profile

**Role: Steam Team Volunteer** 

**Responsible to:** Steam Curator

Purpose: To maintain and present steam collection for visitors

# Responsibilities:

Carry out designated work safely and effectively; and to respond to any emergency with steam plant and machinery

# **Key Activities:**

- 1. Undertake necessary maintenance in accordance with set guidance of steam plant and machinery includes boilers, engines, pumps and systems
- 2. Ensure safe running of plant and machinery includes regular boiler instrumentation pressure tests in accordance with Operating Instructions.
- 3. Complete log sheets as part of operating regime to record working output and to highlight any defects
- 4. Undertake special projects as planned by curator includes conservation and restoration, for example spinning mule
- 5. Provide knowledgeable interpretation to mill visitors

#### **Commitment:**

Current team meets Tues evening (7-9pm) and Thursday all day to undertake tasks.

#### **Personal Attributes:**

Strong commitment together with interest in and dedication to heritage steam; underpinned by aptitude for practical [and often dirty] work. Good team player.

## Skills and Experience:

Basic understanding and knowledge of machinery - not necessarily to engineering level as training will be given.

Ideally previous team working with preparedness to be flexible.

## **Support and Training provided:**

Induction by steam curator and lead members, and mutual support of team colleagues. Tasks allocated taking account of specific personal abilities but broadened with experience.

Regular team meetings - 'toolbox talks' to help confidence and extend knowledge.

This is a voluntary role and this arrangement should not be seen as either a legally binding or an employment contract
