Role: Weaving Volunteer

Responsible to: Weaving Manager

Purpose:

To support weaving production and maintenance, and demonstrate to visitors.

Responsibilities:

To undertake safe running of machines and generally support efficient operation of processes within Department.

Key Activities:

- 1. Run designated machines presently pirn and comb winders, but extended with development of role holder's knowledge and experience
- 2. Sort yarn and bag materials
- 3. Carry out guided visitor tours on spinning process
- 4. Respond to enquiries from mill visitors.
- 5. Mentor and support other team members.

Commitment:

Minimum 3 hours per week.
